Eighteen Policies, set out here for the authority and Community
Commitments which, once agreed, will ensure a greater conformity
towards delivering our Vision and Objectives.

We have included the 18 Policies into 8 themes for the sake of
convenience and clarity.

The Five Themes are:

- Planning Policy**
- Housing Policy**
- Transport and Communications Policy**
